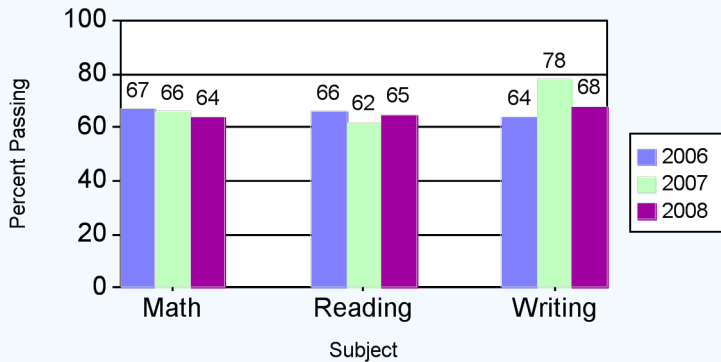
School Mission and Goals

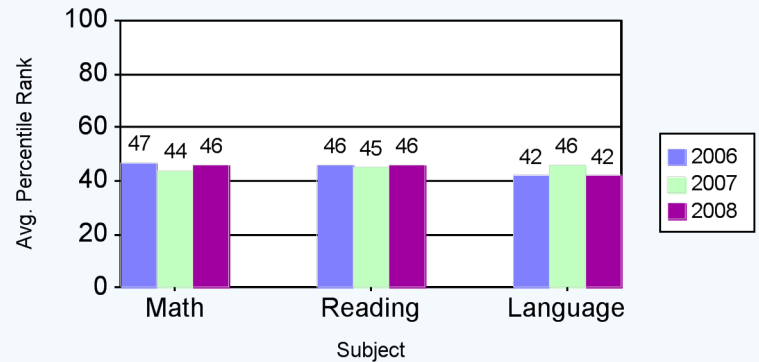
